The Northwest Independent School District (NISD) is one of the fastest-growing districts in Texas. With over 30 schools; a new distribution center; more than 5,000 staff members; and almost 30,000 students, accurately managing and tracking assets is critical.

“The data and inventory management capabilities of Destiny have enabled huge improvements that help me be more efficient in my job,” said Piper-McClure. “Being able to track not only textbooks but all of our other curriculum consumables and resources under one software system really helps optimize the process.”

With Destiny Resource Manager, staff can quickly and easily track what resources the district has and pinpoint where they are. Resources can be tracked as they follow staff and students when they move between schools – an essential feature, as students keep their school-issued laptops year-round from sixth grade through graduation. When every dollar counts, having an accurate accounting of high-cost resources, like computers, ensures a high level of essential fiscal responsibility.



“With Destiny, we’ve been able to find more resources that were not in our inventory, as well as find equipment that needed to be retired out of circulation,” said Ervin. “I like having the ability to transfer materials from campus to campus when necessary to help avoid overage purchasing and having the ability to pull reports on anything still outstanding or lost. This function helps us mitigate repurchase and adds a high level of accountability. Overall, the reporting functions in Destiny Resource Manager have allowed us to save the district money.”

The district shares Destiny Resource Manager with many different departments, which allows the district to fully utilize the software’s cost-saving features. “Not only do we use it for technology and textbook resources, it is also used by the Fine Arts department, CTE, and the district office staff relies on Destiny to inventory AV equipment, surplus items they check out, as well as technology items they purchase,” explained Ervin. The fast-growing district has nearly doubled its enrollment in the last decade, and it continues to expand. That type of rapid population increase can make budgeting and purchase planning difficult, but the data aggregated in Destiny Resource Manager has helped staff make huge strides toward keeping pace with the growth.

“Our district is growing rapidly, so we use the reporting and enrollment features of Destiny to accurately order for this growth – and ordering for growth and accuracy

saves us money,” said Piper-McClure. “We are using the reporting features to track down missing books and replace damaged materials as needed. We had a major flood at a campus this year and were able to account for everything within a day. Saving the time and payroll was well worth it.”

The tracking capabilities of Destiny Resource Manager have made a world of difference for the district. From the warehouse to the campus level, the accuracy and accountability are saving time and money. “Reporting is a major function within Destiny, which allows us to compute figures and numbers for writing bond proposals and forecasting,” Ervin shared. “Destiny not only saves us time but also ensures quality reporting.”
